FEDERAL SURVEY CARDS

During this time of continuing economic uncertainty, SDUSD must continue to pursue every potential source of funding to support our important work of preparing our students for success.

Impact Aid Funds are designated to assist school districts that lose tax revenue due to their enrollment of students from families who live or work on tax-exempt federal properties or are active duty military personnel. Our schools are heavily impacted with federally-connected students.

Impact Aid funds are part of the District's general operating budget and support instructional activities for *all students* at every school.

To qualify for Impact Aid funding, the U.S. Department of Education requires the District to survey students to determine eligibility. Therefore we ask all parents/guardians to complete the survey that was mailed to your home with information as of October 7, 2020.

For your convenience, a prepaid postage envelope was provided so that you may return your survey directly to our District office.

Your cooperation in returning the completed form as soon as possible is greatly appreciated. The more forms returned, the greater the amount of funds available to our schools. If you have any questions, please contact the Impact Aid Office at (619) 725-7593.
